
SERVICES PROVIDED

Services are undertaken through reference to best practice guidance including: 'Guidelines for Landscape and Visual Impact Assessment' Third Edition (2013) (GLVIA3). All Services include a proportionate level of stakeholder engagement. Scope of Services offered include:

- Landscape Scale Studies to guide land use and inform development planning, including
 Character Assessments of Landscape / Townscape / Seascape; Landscape Sensitivity / Capacity
 Studies and Green Infrastructure Strategies
- Landscape and Visual Appraisal / Landscape Capacity Studies, to inform suitability of land for development and provide a landscape led approach to achieving this
- Landscape and Visual Impact Assessment (LVIA), from a short statement of opinion to a
 stand-alone report or a chapter within an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA). In addition LVIA
 Audit can be undertaken to determine the relative appropriateness of any professional judgements
 made within an existing LVIA
- Expert Witness Services, where proposals require a proof of evidence and representation at a public inquiry
- Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Coordination, where there are likely to be significant environmental effects arising from a development. EIA Coordination more effectively manages environmental risk and enables integrated development of environmental design and mitigation proposals
- Landscape Management Plan Services, to achieve a landscape vision over time
